Christian Unity Prayer Service: January 23, 7:00 pm

We will have an ecumenical prayer service at St. Peter's on Tuesday, January 23, at 7:00 pm to mark the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. With roots going back over 100 years, the dedicated octave of prayers has been jointly commissioned and prepared since 1966, after the Second Vatican Council, by the Roman Catholic Church and the World Council of Churches. This is a special opportunity for Christians to gather together, remembering our common Baptism, and pray that we may more fully live out the mission Jesus has given us. Each year ecumenical partners in a different region are asked to prepare the materials. The materials for the 2024 Week of Prayer for Christian Unity were prepared by an ecumenical team from Burkina Faso facilitated by the local Chemin Neuf Community (CCN). The theme chosen is "You shall love the Lord your God ... and your neighbour as yourself" (Lk 10:27). Brothers and sisters from the Catholic Archdiocese of Ouagadougou, Protestant Churches, ecumenical bodies and the CCN in Burkina Faso collaborated generously in drafting the prayers and reflections and experienced their work together as a real path of ecumenical conversion. There will be a reception in the hall following the prayer service.
