Eucharistic Ministers: Please note.

- 1. Communion ministers come to the sanctuary during the "Lamb of God". They do not bow unless they cross at the center aisle; then they bow to the altar. They return to their places without bowing unless they cross at the center.
- 2. Whether masks are worn while distributing communion will be evaluated on an ongoing basis. If the priest wears a mask, please wear one. If wearing a mask, the communion ministers sanitize hands after receiving communion and putting back on their masks. If not wearing a mask, sanitize hands before receiving communion. Please wash hands with water following the distribution of communion.
- 3. The communion minister should only use the towel provided to wipe their hands.
- 4. When you distribute Holy Communion, when you show the Host, you say, "The Body of Christ".
- 5. When a person requests a blessing rather than receiving the Eucharist, the communion minister says "May God bless you", without touching the person.
- 6. Give the vessel containing the remaining hosts back to the priest or place on the altar.
