Eucharistic Ministers: Please note.

1. Communion ministers come to the sanctuary during the "Lamb of God". They do not bow unless they cross at the center aisle; then they bow to the altar. They return to their places without bowing unless they cross at the center.
2. Whether masks are worn while distributing communion will be evaluated on an ongoing basis. If the priest wears a mask, please wear one. If wearing a mask, the communion ministers sanitize hands after receiving communion and putting back on their masks. If not wearing a mask, sanitize hands before receiving communion. Please wash hands with water following the distribution of communion.
3. The communion minister should only use the towel provided to wipe their hands.
4. When you distribute Holy Communion, when you show the Host, you say, "The Body of Christ".
5. When a person requests a blessing rather than receiving the Eucharist, the communion minister says "May God bless you", without touching the person.
6. Give the vessel containing the remaining hosts back to the priest or place on the altar.
